SARCOCHILUS IN THE NEWS - - - E.D.H.

In a recent paper published in Sydney by the Australasian Native Orchid Society, A.W.Dockrill transfers our Sarcochilus adversus to the genus Drymoanthus W.H.Nicholls. I haven't yet seen this paper, so know nothing of his reasons for so doing, but if Dr. Moore decides to follow Dockrill, the New Zealand plant will become Drymoanthus adversus (Hook.f.) Dockr. Australasian Sarcanthinae, 1967; p32.t3, and Drymoanthus will consist of 2 species, D.minutus Nich. in North Queensland and D.adversus in New Zealand.
